Replacement of courses on disciplinary methods

Who is allowed to take an alternative course?

According to the MSD study regulations, students have to take three courses on disciplinary methods. In the medium-term syllabus, alternative method courses of a higher level are published from spring semester 2023 on. These alternatives are only eligible for students with preliminary knowledge and first degrees in this field. I.e., by default, students enroll in the officially published courses (48955, 60867 or 43494). For details see medium-term syllabus (see website MSD/downloads MSD2017).

How to proceed?

The student clarifies beforehand with the faculty representative (see list of names below) whether she/he is allowed to take an alternative course. If so,

- a) the student fills in this LA on the computer (use ADOBE ACROBAT !!!) and signs it digitally;
- b) send the signed LA to the responsible faculty representative who has to sign as well and sends the LA back to the student.
- c) the students submits the fully signed LA to the coordination office MSD: coordination-msd@unibas.ch
